Forgive me for the brevity of my updates this time. I'd like to draw your focus to a significant prayer request for the nation of Peru, that I will get to on the next page.

You may recall in my last newsletter I mentioned how I was teaching English for a month? Well, I was enjoying it so much I thought I'd ask God if He could provide more opportunities for me to continue in this, and sure enough, due to a scheduling

conflict with the original teacher, the director of the seminary asked me if I could continue teaching this class 3 times per week for the rest of the school year (until November).

This is a great privilege, so thank you for your prayers! God's really stretching me and showing me creative ways of teaching Bible doctrines by posting Scripture references on a white board in English and going through them word for word to help the students 'get' English. This is proving to be helpful to the students currently in the class, as they are already knowledgeable of the passages I use in their own language.

Please continue to lift this up in prayer, as I've committed to continuing this on a one-month-at-a-time basis, not knowing if in the months to come this will conflict with some other responsibilities and opportunities in my ministry with *Fire Peru*. God seems to be opening up some doors to travel and spend a few days at a time in areas where we have fellowships that have partnered or networked with us, and who could use some discipleship and leadership training. After being here 2 years now, I'm *finally* getting comfortable traveling and doing some things on my own and the language barrier--and cultural difference--is not as big of a hurdle anymore to building discipleship relationships.

By no means is my Spanish perfect, but I don't always need an interpreter to help me everywhere I go now. Pray with me as God enables me to be an effective impact and influence on a few select men/leaders, that God would in turn enable them to become an effective impact on their disciples and church fellowships.

### Peruvian Elections

Time and space don't permit me to go into too much detail or explain in depth, but please be in prayer for June 5th. On this date Peruvians will take to the polls for a run-off election, and choose the president for this nation. The two candidates who received the most votes in the recent general election are not candidates the majority of Peru voted on, and I've heard a pundit here say that the two options in the run-off are like choosing between cancer or AIDS. The candidate who received the most votes in April's general election, Ollanta Humala is very closely associated to Hugo Chavez in Venezuela. The other runner up is the 35 year-old Keiko Fujimori, inexperienced daughter of former Peruvian president during the 1990s, whose leadership style was likened by some as that of a dictator also.

It's difficult to predict who will win, but at either rate, it will bring radical change to this nation. Humala, narrowly lost in the elections in 2006 and in that campaign had vowed to kick out all foreigners and implement a nationalist/socialistic agenda among other things. This time he ran more moderately, but many Peruvians in Lima fear either of the two candidates being elected.

God is in control, and knows what He's doing, and I believe I'm in the center of His will for this time in my life, and have given very thoughtful prayer to the idea of my time in Peru possibly being shortened. It is also causing me to evaluate what kind of fruit I'm producing and how to make the best use of my time in case I'm not going to be here for long. Friends here have encouraged me to doubt anything will change for my destiny in this nation. I encourage you to Google search online about the election to learn more details to understand how this is being perceived.
